

QUANTITATIVE 3 GOALS

1. By June 2015 the superintendent will enhance communication with all stakeholders in order to increase parent participation and involvement in scholastic activities. The superintendent will create a variety of activities designed which will include but will not be limited to the following:
 - a. Four (4) e-newsletters that will successfully reach at least 70% of district parents having an active email address.
 - b. 3 specific, parent information and participation programs through our Family Support Center. .
 - c. 5 press releases celebrating student and staff achievements.
 - d. 4 "Coffee with the Superintendent" morning or afternoon meetings, which are agenda driven and tied to the district goals for student achievement.
 - e. 2 web casts
2. By June 2015 70% of all third grade students will be reading on or above grade level as determined by Benchmark tests, running records, and DRA.
3. By June 2015 the District will have secured funding for and begin building the Bellmawr Early Childhood Center on the Bellmawr Park site.

QUALITATIVE 2 GOALS

1. The superintendent will direct staff to design and create a data collection system that will track student achievement in English Language Arts and Math in order to use data to inform and adjust instruction. Data binders will be in place by October 2014 and utilized throughout the year.
2. The k-5 math teachers will meet monthly to research and choose a new math program that is aligned to the Common Core in order to be prepared for implementation in September 2015.
